Marty Milstead is the President of the Mississippi Automobile Dealers Association, a trade organization representing the franchised automobile dealers. He was named to the post in November 2015. Milstead is responsible for the organization's affairs which includes representation at the state Capitol, the Mississippi Congressional delegation, the Mississippi Motor Vehicle Commission, promoting the franchised dealers, and serving as administrator of the MADA Self Insured Fund.

Prior to serving as President of MADA, Milstead worked on the staff of US Senator Trent Lott, and the Republican National Committee. In 1988 he became Executive Vice President of the Home Builders Association of Mississippi

where he grew the organization to become one of the top trade groups in the state. He successfully started two insurance companies, the Builders and Contractors Associations of Mississippi Self Insures Fund serving as the Chief Executive Officer and President of the National Builders and Contractors Insurance Company.

Milstead earned a degree in business administration from the University of Southern Mississippi.

Milstead has held leadership positions on statewide and national boards, including but not limited to the NAHB Executive Officers Council, Mississippi Society of Association Executives, Business and Industry Political and Education Committee, and Mississippi Association of Self Insures.
